The Dalai Lama Graduate Scholarship 2026/27

GUIDELINE FOR RENEWAL APPLICATION

To renew your scholarship for the 2026/27 academic year, you must submit a complete online application along with the following supporting documents:

- Written progress statement (maximum two pages) detailing your academic progress toward your degree, including any immediate plans such as summer employment or research.
- Letter of good standing from your university registrar confirming your full-time student status and current GPA or academic marks.
- Updated Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- Official transcript reflecting your latest grades.
- Financial statement outlining any changes in financial status or university funding for 2026. If applicable, include a copy of your most recent income tax return or SAR/FAFSA forms.
- Copy of a valid Green Book, showing Dhanglang Chatrel dues paid up to 2025 (include the first page, second page, and the most recent payment page).
- All required documents must be submitted online by the April 19, 2026 deadline. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Deadline

The complete application form and all supporting documents must be submitted online by **April 19, 2026, at 11:59 PM Zurich time (GMT+1)**. Applications must be complete, accurate, and submitted on time. After the deadline, the online portal will be closed, and late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

All applicants will receive an email confirmation upon submission. The independent Selection Committee will carefully review and evaluate all renewal applications. Please note that renewal is not automatic.
